



East Milton Square

Parking And Access Design Project

Location: East Milton Square bounded by the intersections of:

- Squantum Street and Granite Avenue to the north.
- Adams Street, Centre Street and Pleasant Street to the west.
- Adams Street, Beale Street and Stedman Street to the east.
- Boulevard Street and Granite Avenue to the south.



Goal: to take the Hybrid Alternative Concept Plan developed through the Parking and Access Design Study and make it into a buildable design through the MassDOT process. Overall project goals include increasing access for all modes of transportation to East Milton Square, improving parking, knitting the Square together by improving local connections over I-93, and fostering the long term business vitality of the area.

Outcome: an actionable plan for design, approved by the Town of Milton that addresses the project goals and is ready to advertise for construction.

Project timeline: expected to be ready to advertise for construction in fiscal year 2015.

Project cost: approximately \$290,000.

Citizen input: Your input to the project is solicited and appreciated and there will be opportunities for members of the public to offer their thoughts throughout the project. Both the project team and the Town of Milton believe that a project of this magnitude should be done *with* the community and not just *for* it. A significant milestone of the project will be the MassDOT 25% design public hearing.
